Artist Profile

Heike Krause, known under the name TrashmaidBerlin, is a Berlin-based artist rooted in Street Art and active in Trash Art since 2018. She transforms found waste – primarily debris from marine beaches and Berlin's streets – into visually striking, socially engaged artworks. Her work addresses the global plastic crisis and its local manifestations, often placing art directly in public spaces. With a professional background in advertising and communication, she uses visual culture as a tool for environmental awareness and public dialogue.

In 2025, she won first prize in the category "Worldwide" at the international Trash Art Awards organized by *The Trash Traveler* with her work *Flight 281*. The award recognizes her ability to translate ecological issues into art with both formal clarity and emotional depth. The winning piece — a sculpture made from 281 collected cigarette butts and plastic fragments from marine beaches — exemplifies her artistic approach: socially critical, precisely composed, and rooted in a global context.
